- Disseminate up-to-date and consistent information on the Level 2 BIM programme
- Allow a local feedback mechanism to the BIM Task Group
- Create regional networks for knowledge exchange, best practice and support

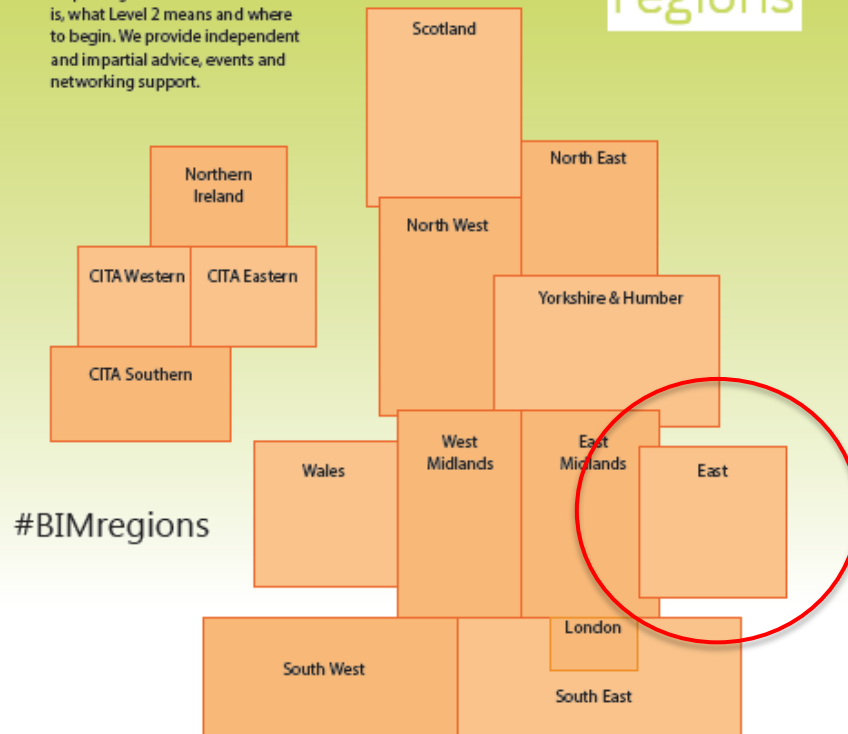
What are the BIM Regions?

- Re-launched in Sept 2015 as 'BIM Regions'
- No funding or central support!!
- Run and attended by those who believe in disruptive change for the better

Digitising our future



The BIM Regions provide local networks where anyone can get help and guidance about what BIM is, what Level 2 means and where to begin. We provide independent and impartial advice, events and networking support.



15 *main* regions active throughout the UK & Ireland

BIM Regions UK targets in 2016

- Growth – Reach out to gain a critical mass understanding **25,000**
- Website under construction - accessible information and updates
- Funding generated at a national level distributed to the regions
- Regional events to remain free or low cost
- Minimum of 3 events per year for each region
- Partnering with BIM4s community, Constructing Excellence etc.

- Started up previously under the 'BIM Hub' branding
- Some good events were put on, but unfortunately petered out
